"Roland, a Durham-based artist, received his BFA in design and MFA in studio art from the University of North Carolina-Greensboro. Since 2016, he has been running "The Jumpsuit Project", a performance piece that grew out of the ten months he spent in state prison on a wrongful conviction, in 2013, while in graduate school. After being released, Roland continued to wear the orange jumpsuit for the duration of his MFA, challenging the stigmas and prejudice of the incarcerated. In 2015, he was exonerated; he has since continued to raise awareness to social issues surrounding mass incarceration with his art".
